Panel space is limited this year, but we are particularly interested in papers addressing topics related to the following:

- Warren's literary associations
- How Warren was influenced by others' work
- How Warren influenced his contemporaries
- How Warren's influence continues to impact literature, criticism, and teaching

We invite abstracts for papers, panels, or roundtables addressing any aspect of Robert Penn Warren's work, but are especially interested in maintaining a focus on the conference theme. For individual paper proposals, please send paper title and abstract of 50-100 words. For panel proposals, please include panel title, name and affiliation of each presenter, and individual abstracts of 50 - 100 words with paper title. For roundtables, please send an abstract of 50 - 100 words and a brief bio of each speaker.
